



# SOUTH PENDER ISLAND LOCAL TRUST COMMITTEE

## BYLAW NO. 105

### SCHEDULE 1

“South Pender Island Official Community Plan, 2002”, Bylaw No. 91, is amended as follows:

1. Section A (Goals) of Part II (Goals, Objectives and General Polices) is amended by inserting the following as a new Goal 7:
  - “7. To support the provincial target of reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 33% by 2020 from 2007 levels. Emission reductions within the local trust area may result from individual and community initiatives, the actions of other levels of government, technological changes, and changes to land use policies and regulations.”
2. Section C (General Policies) of Part II (Goals, Objectives and General Polices) is amended by inserting the following as a new Policy 6:
  - “6. In its decision-making, the Local Trust Committee should ensure that land use planning and development promote reductions in greenhouse gas emissions, support efforts to adapt to climate change impacts, and recognize the role of existing rural and natural areas in the absorption of carbon.”
3. Section E (Agricultural Land Use and Development) of Part III (Land-Based Use and Development) is amended replacing the word “statue” with the word “statute”, deleting final instance of the word “and,” from objective 1(b), replacing the period at the end of objective 1(c) with “; and,” and by inserting the following as a new objective 1(d):
  - “d) To increase local food security and sustainable agriculture, including community gardens and local land trusts in appropriate locations.”
4. Section F (Forest Land Use and Development) of Part III (Land-Based Use and Development) is amended by inserting the following as a new policy 2(g):
  - “g) Landowners and residents are encouraged to retain and restore forests as a means of storing carbon.”
5. Section G (Parks and Outdoor Recreation Land Use and Development) of Part III (Land-Based Use and Development) is amended by inserting the following as a new policy 2(e):
  - “e) The Local Trust Committee encourages protection, retention and restoration of protected areas as a means of storing carbon.”
6. Section A (Transportation Services) of Part VI (Provision of Services and Utilities), is amended by inserting the following as a new Transportation General Objective 1(b):
  - “b) To recognize the role of transportation in producing greenhouse gas emissions and the value of identifying options to reduce emissions including alternative forms of transportation.”
7. Section A (Transportation Services) of Part VI (Provision of Services and Utilities), is amended by inserting the following as a new Land Transportation Objective 3(a)(ii) :
  - “ii) To encourage and support alternative transportation initiatives, including, but not limited to, car stops, neighbourhood zero emission vehicles, car shares, a bicycle path network and walking trails.”
8. Section B (Communication and Utility Services) of Part VI (Provision of Services and Utilities), is amended by inserting the following as a new Communication and Utility policy 2(d):

- “d) Providers of internet and other electronic communications services are encouraged to expand and improve the delivery of services to, and the development of infrastructure for, the local community.”
