October 6, 2010	GM-082-2010	Guidelines for the appointment of members to the advisory planning commission	<p>It was MOVED and SECONDED that the Gambier Island Local Trust Committee endorses the following guidelines for the appointment of members to the advisory planning commission and requests that such guidelines be posted on the Islands Trust website and are used in any posting to solicit expressions of interest from candidates for advisory planning commission membership:</p> <p>“The Gambier Island Local Trust Committee shall make all reasonable efforts, in the consideration of appointments to the advisory planning commission that members are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. representative of a broad cross section of the geographical areas of the Gambier Island Local Trust Committee area; b. representative of a range of backgrounds and expertise that is supportive to each other in the consideration of matters referred to the advisory planning commission c. where feasible and practical of a balanced representation of gender and age groups. <p>Consideration shall be given to the following criteria in any appointment:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Previous experience as a member of a Board of Variance ▪ Experience on a local government council, board, local trust committee, commission or other body ▪ Experience with other volunteer boards, commissions or committees ▪ Experience and credential in a planning, design or related profession ▪ Experience and credentials in a building or design trade ▪ Educational background ▪ Length of residency in the local trust area <p>Availability, and willingness to travel between local trust areas.”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪
