Making a difference...together

- Is responsible for solid waste management plans under provincial leg.
- Develops strategies based on the 5R pollution prevention hierarchy
- Manages solid waste disposal (at Hartland landfill)
- Provides a range of residential recycling services (direct or contracted)
- Regulates the operation of composting facilities in the region
- Can license solid waste facilities (currently only on Salt Spring)



Islands Trust

- Land Use Planning: Zones land to allow waste management facility uses
- Regulates "use" and "density"
- Regulates the siting and size of buildings
