

## **LOCAL TRUSTEE REPORT BY JEANINE DODDS –MAYNE ISLAND LTC FALL EDITION**

The Mayne Island Local Trust Committee did not meet prior to this report being prepared. At the meeting of October 30th the committee will have had a community information meeting on the Staff report of the Commercial Land Use Review. The review is looking at properties currently zoned for commercial use, undeveloped potential in the current zoning and clarifying policies to provide guidance for assessing rezonings in the future. As well a first reading for a bylaw imposing the Riparian Area Regulations on the two water courses having been identified as having potential for fish presence is expected to be before the Committee.

Currently the Local Trust Committee has received a number of letters from concerned community members regarding the possible closure of the garbage service. The current service has had complaints directed to Islands Trust Bylaw which the operators have relayed to their customers.

The local Trust Committee is committed to reviewing options for garbage services in view of the closure of the Waste Transfer station operating from the Bennett's property. At our meeting of October 30th it is expected that Staff will be directed to work with the current operators of the door to door service on solutions to management of garbage.

The Committee will next meet on November 27, at the Agricultural Hall at 1pm.
