**QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE**

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day, March 2, 2019;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;

- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

#### CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the Local Elections Campaign Financing Act, for the Hornby Island by-election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

Islands Trust Local Trust Area Trustee    \$5,000

#### THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING LIMITS

In accordance with the Local Elections Campaign Financing Act, for the Hornby Island by-election, the following third party advertising limits apply:

Directed Advertising Expense Limit	\$750
Cumulative Advertising Limit	\$150,000
