My understanding is that these are proposals by the trustees, (not being requested by the residents, nor by the Islands Trust), and the residents should know this. If there have been public requests for change to the bylaws we should be advised of this also, and to which bylaw.

I have looked on the website and none of what I am requesting appears to be there.
